### ***Professional Experience***

With over 25 years of experience in law enforcement, Fran joins the firm with decades of expertise in criminal investigations, interview/interrogation, traffic law, law enforcement policy and procedures, and a myriad of related topics within the public safety profession. He served honorably as a non-commissioned officer with the United States Air Force and New Jersey Air National Guard and recently returned to service as a contractor teaching USAF personnel at the USAF Air Advisor Academy in "Use of Force", "De-escalation of Conflict", and several other topics.
